Networked Publics:

 Social media, community technologies, big social data, Wikipedia, learning networks

Third Places:

- Public places away from home and work
- Gathering places for conversation
- Essential for the emergence of communities and collective action

Addressing Online "Hostile Environments"

- A hostile work environment is a form of harassment.
- Online public networks may also be hostile environments, characterized by the cumulative effect of conduct in social media so severe and pervasive it interferes with a citizen's ability to engage in public discourse.



Social media systems seeking to foster a culture of civic discourse should enact a zero tolerance policy.

An identity separate from the "real" you, so that participation in public discourse online cannot lead to personal harm

 Yet, a persistent identity that may develop its own reputation over time, to increase accountability
